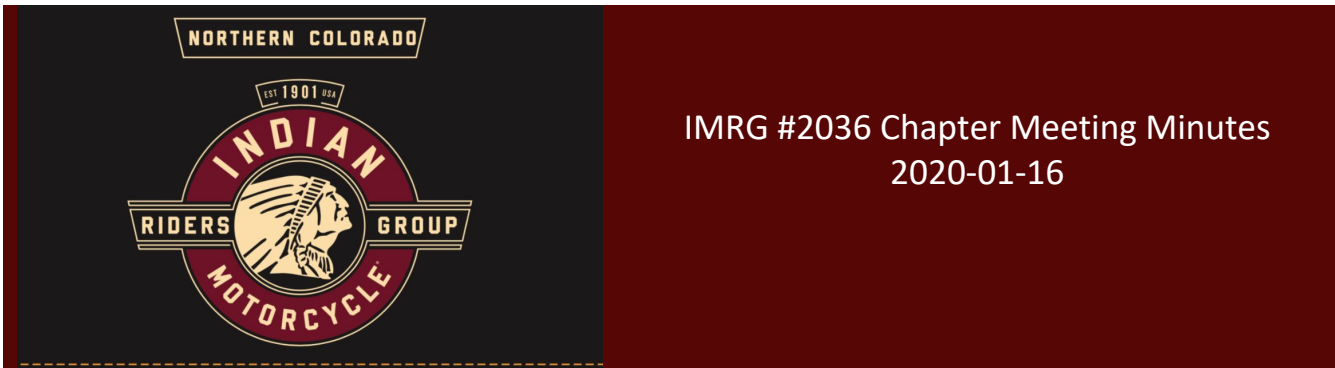
Terry Connett asked Ron to give an update on the Durango Rendezvous. Rooms are filling up fast.

Trish reported she will be sending out a welcome letter to new bike owners explaining about our Chapter and inviting them to join.

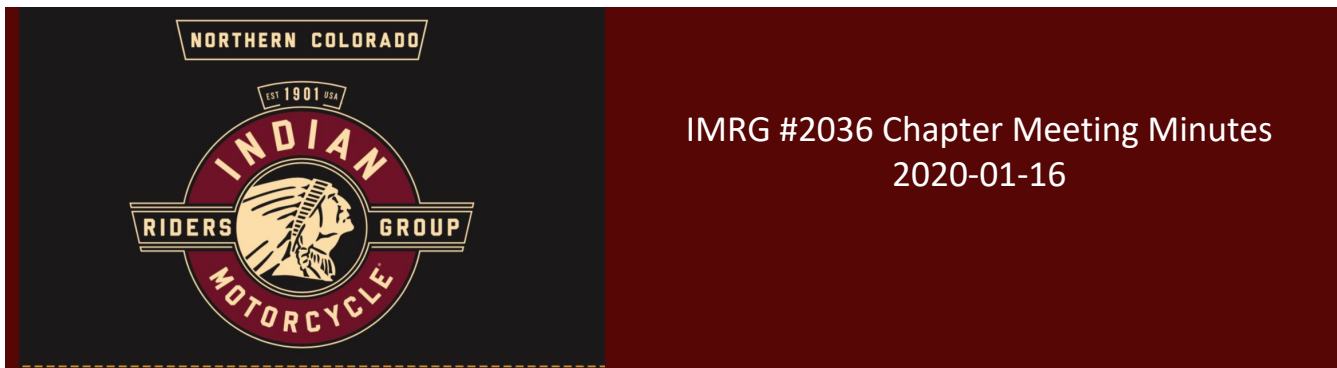
