Ron spoke about the new IMRG program –

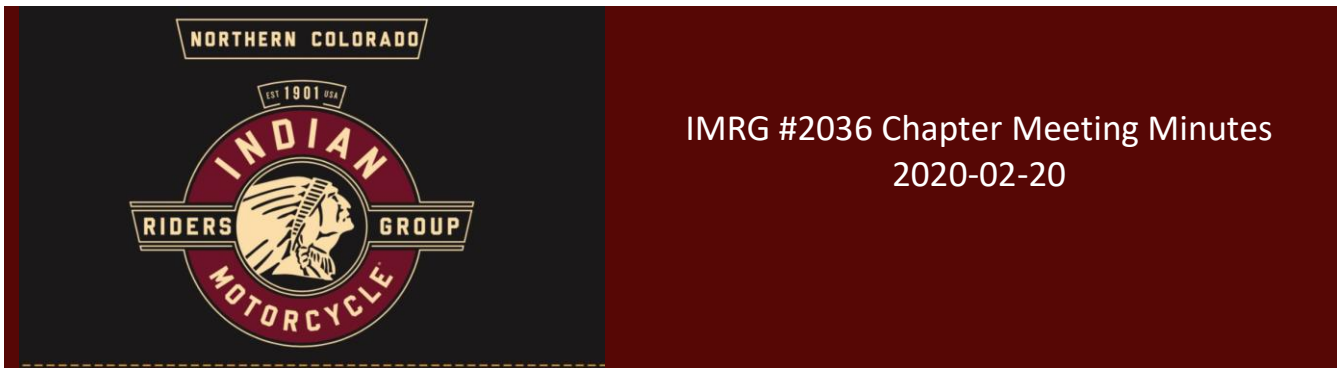

The Informer was sent out with “Swap Your Swag” information on it. Jeff held up the tee shirt that will be given out.

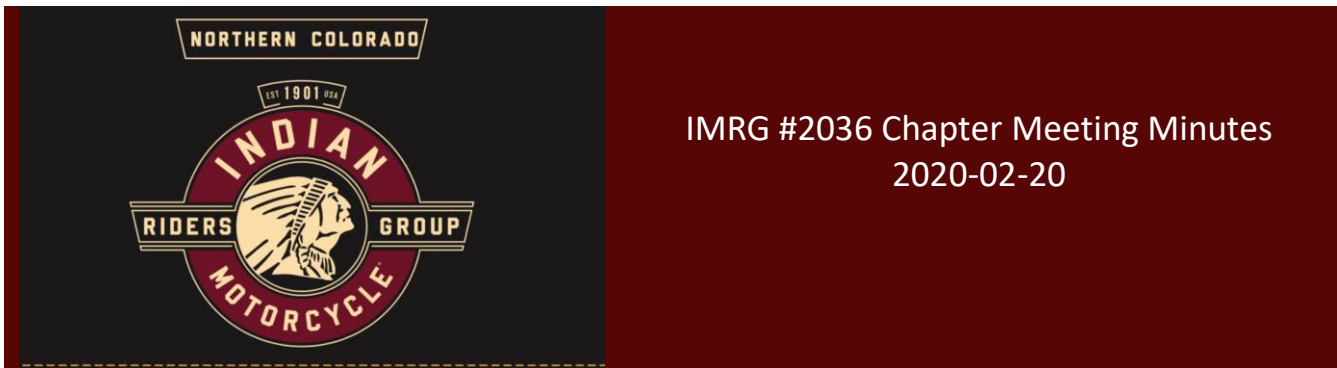
