We have a new member; we are up to 36.

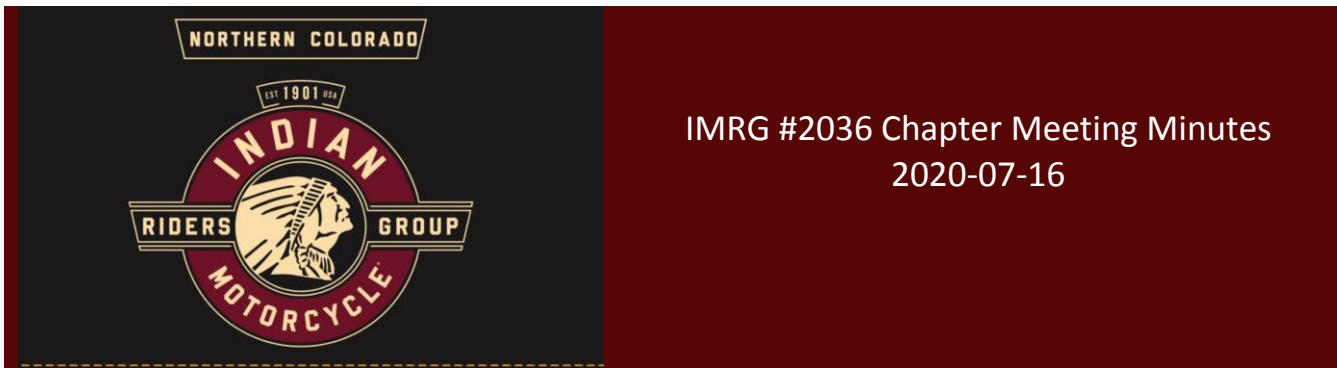
Marketing Director – Randall Holman

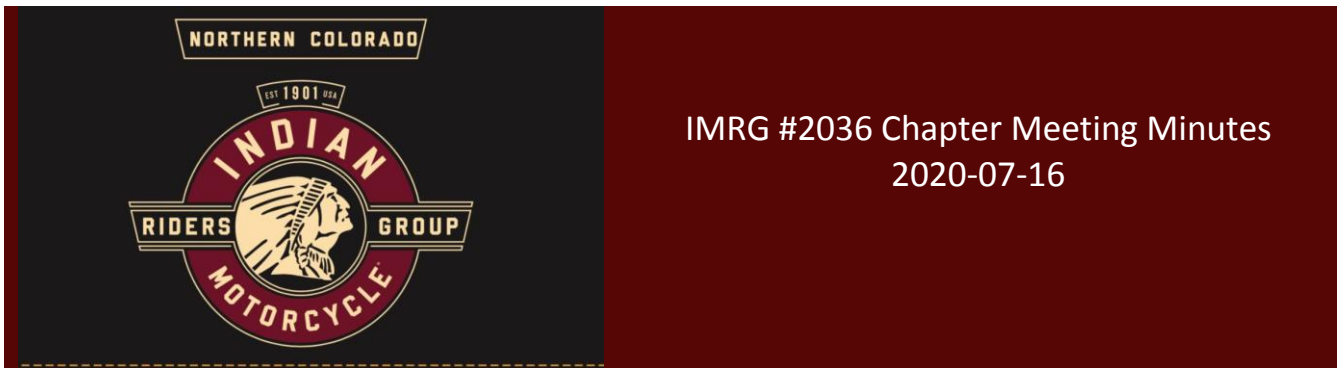
Safety tips up on social media. Paul spoke about Clearwater lights vs. moto lights in the article and encourages everyone to read it.

When coming to a stop, do not put both feet on the ground, keep the right on the brake in order to be prepared if you need to make a quick escape.
