Vice President - Paul Carroll

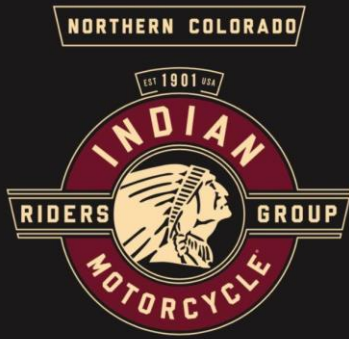
- Name patches have been ordered. Hopefully will be ready by end of May. If you did not get one ordered, let Paul Carroll know and he can get one ordered for you.
