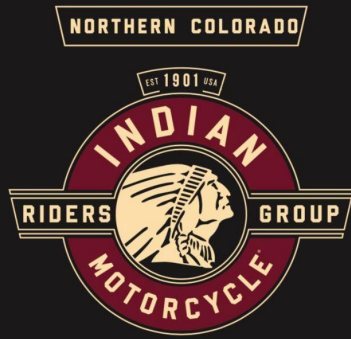


Meeting called to order at 6.33 p.m.

- Old Business

 - Packing for trips – tips on how to pack were shared: some people roll their clothes, some fold the clothes and stack them, some use vacuum bags. Fold shirts, pants, etc. and then put the small stuff in the corners or extra space in the suitcase. If you are staying in the same place every night, you pack differently than if you are changing hotels every night. Make sure that everything fits in zip baggies (which come in all sizes) and then these bags fit into place. How do you keep your wet clothes/shoes separate from other clothes and how do you keep clothes from mildewing? We all need to be prepared when traveling. Also know the group you are traveling with – does someone have an air compressor, tool kit, extra gas, bungee cords, etc? Rok straps are another option versus bungee cords. They are designed for motorcycles and more flexible in the ways you can put them on your bike.
