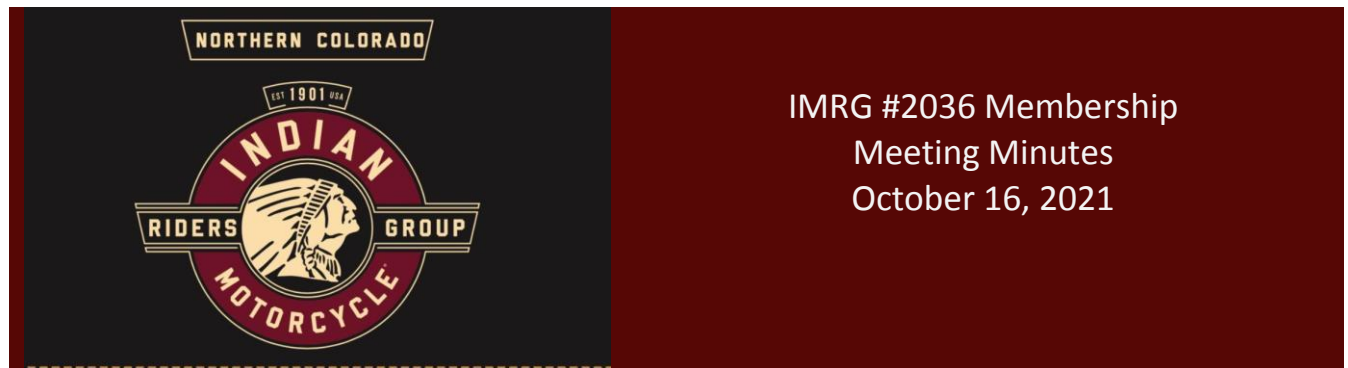


Meeting called to order at 9.36 a.m.

Treasurer - Ted Wolfe

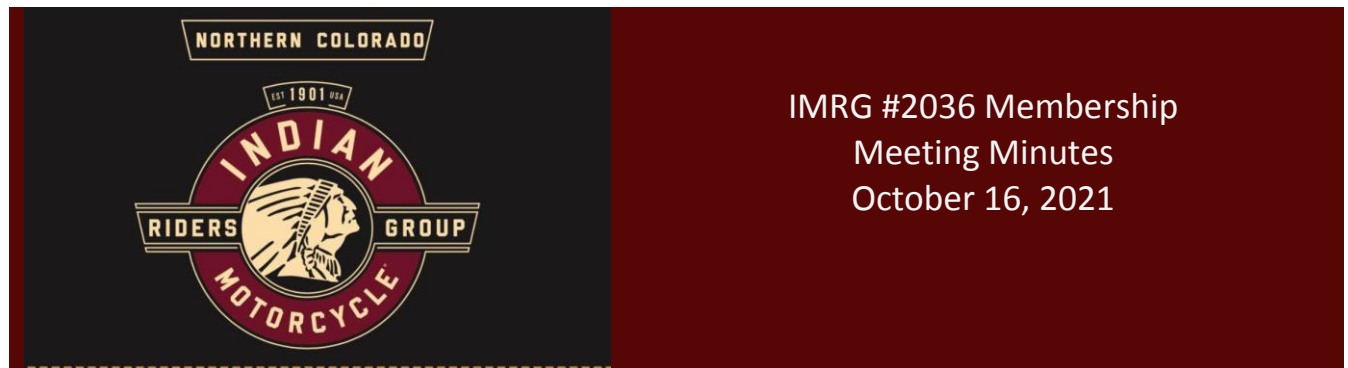
- \$950.00 in our bank account currently plus the \$100 we received from new members.

Safety - Paul Carroll

- Key points to remember to winterize your motorcycles:
 - Fuel stabilizer and full fuel tank. Put stabilizer in first and then top off the tank. Best to use ethanol free fuel. This helps alleviate condensation and potential for rust build up in the fuel tank. Pure-gas.org will show you locations of the ethanol fuel. However you need to watch the octane
 - Battery tender such as super smart tender – batteries tend to self-discharge over time. Clean off the electrodes on the battery and put a small amount of grease on them.
 - Tires – put on a stand or move motorcycle around ever couple weeks
 - Surface prep – giving your bike a good wash and dry completely before putting it away for the winter
 - Add a coat of wax
 - Change oil and oil filter. Use a winter weight oil like SW30.
 - Clean and condition ALL your leathers.
