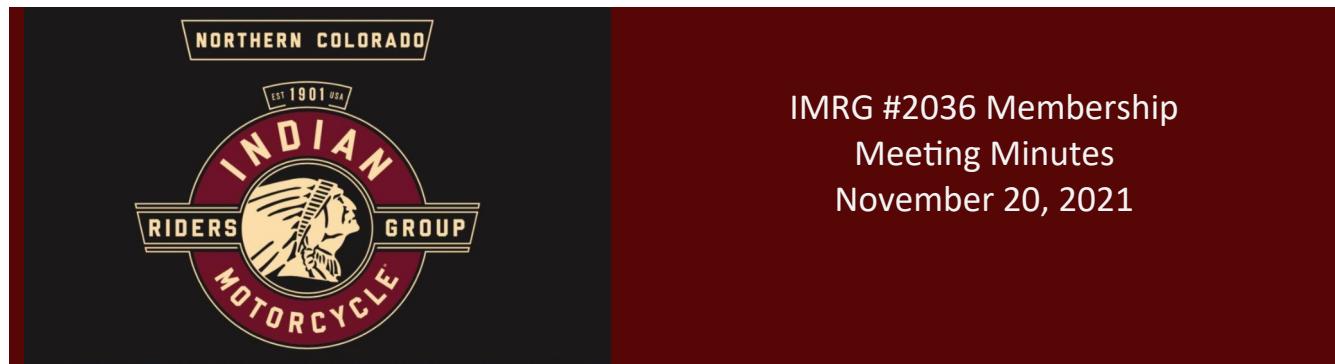


Meeting called to order at 9.40 a.m.

Membership - Paul Neiman

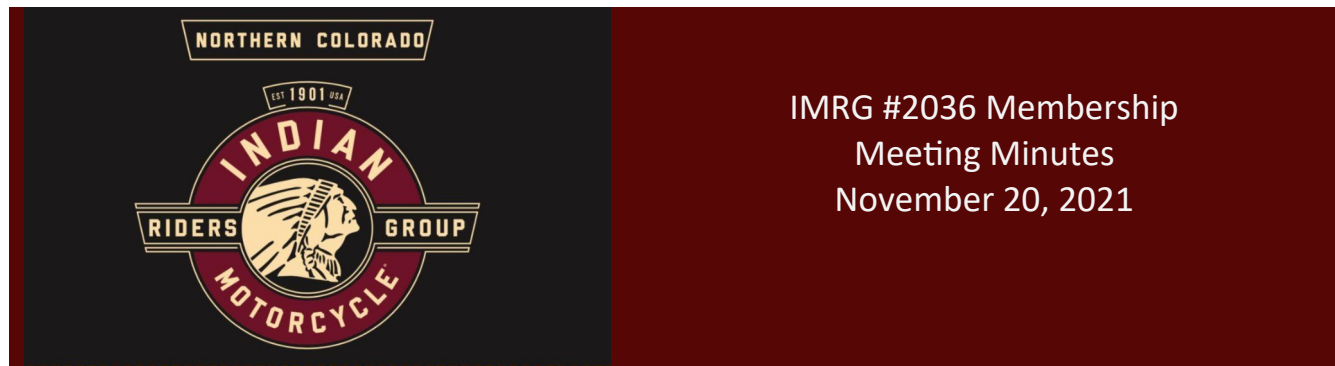
- We are currently at 50 members.
