- Group Ride Etiquette
 - Full tank of gas
 - Empty bladder
 - On time arrival for KSU
 - Ride waivers completed and turned into Karen @ meet up location.
 - Expect to begin and end with the group. If there are extenuating circumstances then let the sweep know where you will be exiting.

- Ride level 1-5
 - Level 1-Flatlander
 - Level 2-Easy with higher speeds and soft curves
 - Level 3-Begin more sweeping curves, longer ride duration, and lower foothills. Example: Horsetooth and Carter Lake
 - Level 4-Tighter curves, tight switchbacks, longer ride duration (½ day). Example: Big Thompson Canyon and Glen Haven
 - Level 5-Great deal of technical riding with sharp curves, switchbacks, full day, and multi day duration. Example: Cameron Pass, Walden, and Independence Pass.
- Lead (Group)-Set the pace, navigate, and plan routes.
- Sweep-Supports group members ahead of them, is the most difficult since they watch riders ahead and support any emergencies or riders that need support.
- Riding formation:
 - Staggered formation.
 - 1 second behind the adjacent rider.
 - Trikes have their own lane and are 2 seconds behind and in front of riders in front and back of them.
- Rider leaves group etiquette.
 - Stay in the same formation.
 - Fill gap @ stop light or in slow moving traffic
 - Watch for the rider ahead to wave when ready to bring the rider up to fill the gap.
- Went over motions or hand signals. "Motorcycle Ballet"
- Mountain riding always ride single file.
