- Official – Indian Motorcycle is now a standalone company
  - February 2nd under the ownership of Carolwood LP
  - Mike Kennedy the helm (who has long time motorcycle industry experience)
- Discussed the new 2026 Indian Chief Vintage
  - Test rode it in Los Angeles
  - Throwback to 1940s Chief
  - 116 ThunderStroke, Valance fenders, tractor seat, full lit headdress, vintage style handlebars
- Talked about experience at the Indian Motorcycle 125<sup>th</sup> Anniversary celebration
  - Met lots of personalities while there – Well known YouTubers, Ambassadors, IMC Engineers, Celebrities, IMC Senior Management, Motorcycle Builders/Customizers, IMC Racing Team
  - Extremely excited about IMC's future
- Talked about the IMRG Council private meeting with IMC
  - 2025 PowerPlus 112 product launch was the strongest, most successful in IMC's history
  - IMC has scored the highest consumer support, loyalty, and satisfaction in the industry
  - Though small (<1%), IMC was still able to gain market share in 2025
  - IMC will be behind many events this year
  - IMC to help with promoting IMRG growth

- Group discussion regarding eliminating the Indian vs non-Indian 25% ratio currently in the By-Laws. Members favored removing this from the By-Laws.
  - Goes against IMC and Regional Council that welcomes and encourages non-Indian motorcycle owners to join IMRG
  - Brian (dealership owner) has already stated the NoCo IMRG should be open to any rider regardless of motorcycle brand
  - The NoCo IMRG has already demonstrated strong camaraderie among the different brand owners in the chapter, and has not shown any “HOG” chapter tendencies.
