President – Randall Holman

- Welcomed members to the March chapter meeting.
 - Introduced new members: Bill, Amy, Chad

 - Flat lander ride taking mostly back county roads – 42 miles (Level-2 ride)
- Swap Your Swag event at the dealership

- Recapped recent Throttle & Iron Podcast where Mike Kennedy was a guest
 - Talking points from Mike Kennedy, CEO Indian Motorcycle:
 - Recognized the IMRG & Community – openly praised IMRG rider passion.
 - Described IMRG as a powerful ally, and IMRG engagement is an essential growth driver for the Indian Motorcycle brand. Expect more product focus:
 - Product issues no longer being deprioritized (e.g. Ride Command). Motorcycle product decisions no longer have to be filtered through unrelated Polaris divisions.
 - IMC will be encouraging and engaging more in the performance and accessories aftermarket

 - Indian came in 1 & 2 for both Daytona races
- Provided a summary of IMRG operational metrics for the South Region and nationally while making comparisons to the local Northern Colorado IMRG – e.g. number of members, number of events, dealership ratings, etc.

 - Registrations are significantly down so far this year
